Subject: Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) Update

Tuition Assistance Plan (TAP) benefits for active UAW-represented Chrysler Group LLC seniority employees have been reinstated for classes that began after January 1, 2012. Effective April 1, eligible employees may file a TAP Application for job-related, degree-seeking courses at nationally and regionally accredited universities.

While development of a new online TAP Voucher system continues, a printable TAP Application form and a printable Reimbursement Application form will be available through the Training tab on the UAW-Chrysler National Training Center website (www.uaw-chrysler.com). Until the online system is functional, these forms must be printed out from the website and mailed or faxed to the TAP office.

As you are aware, TAP guidelines, policies and procedures have changed. The NTC website also provides detailed instructions and information about current employee TAP benefits, eligibility, application and approval processes, as well as school eligibility guidelines.

We encourage you to make employees at your location aware of this information and the opportunity to benefit from TAP.
